# SESRIC STATCAB PROGRAMME



Was initiated in **early 2007**.

Facilitates flow of statistical and professional know-how among NSSs of OIC countries based on a **South-South** and **Triangular Cooperation** approach.

To assess the needs and capacities, SESRIC collects information from the Constituents of the NSSs of OIC countries by conducting **biennial questionnaire**. **Last survey** for biennium 2020-2021 was circulated in **January 2019**.

Based on the corresponding needs and capacities, a **matching** is done among OIC countries to organise short term statistics courses, study visits, and technical missions.




- From the last survey circulated in August 2017 to OIC Countries, **41 countries** submitted a reply (73% response rate).




## Distribution of Respondents by Region






## Distribution of Capacity Building Needed, by Domain






## Distribution of Capacity Building Needed, by Theme






## Distribution of Capacity Building Needed, by Type





by Year, 2007 – 11 March 2019**






## Distribution of Statistical Activities, by Type, 2007 – 11 March 2019






## Number of Statistical Activities Conducted, by Theme, 2007 – 11 March 2019






## TOP 10 COUNTRIES BENEFITED FROM STATCAB, 2007 – 11 March 2019

In accordance with its 2017 Annual Work Plan and within the framework of Statistical Capacity Building (StatCaB) Programme, SESRIC organised the Training Course on 'Population and Housing Censuses; Registers of Population, Dwellings and Buildings' at the Department of Economic Planning and Development (JPKE) of Brunei Darussalam on 22-24 August 2017.

The Training Course was conducted by Ms. Mariet Tetty NURYETTY, Head of Subdirectorate of Health and Housing Statistics, BPS-Statistics Indonesia, with the participation of 33 officials of the JPKE.

As defined in the Classification of Statistical Activities (CSA Rev. 1 - October 2009; <http://goo.gl/olg3Tz>); Population and housing censuses; registers of population, dwellings and buildings cover methodology and organization of population and housing censuses, including register based censuses, development and maintenance of statistical registers of population, buildings and dwellings covering and following the whole resident population.

The Training Course on 'Population and Housing Censuses; Registers of Population, Dwellings and Buildings' included discussion activities with a focus on the following topics:

- Introduction to Population and Housing Censuses,
- Overview of BPS's Population and Housing Censuses',
- Traditional Censuses: Challenge and Opportunity,
- Pre-conditions for Administrative/Register Based Census,
- Dataset Preparation,
- Creating the Registers,
- Data Validation and Processing,
- Managing Different Data Sources, and
- Changing from Traditional Census to Register Based Census – Brunei's Case

- The **UNSD** invited **SESRIC** to be the Founding Members on **1 November 2017**.
- Established on **5 January 2018**.
- Overall objective: Facilitate collaboration among members of the network in the delivery of trainings on **statistics** in a more harmonized and standardized manner.



- Following-up the establishment of GIST, SESRIC attended the **first meeting of GIST on 8 March 2018** in New York, USA. In this meeting, it was identified that there is a need to **pursue multiple streams of work to address various challenges in statistical training.**
- As a follow-up, 5 main work streams were established and **SESRIC is being the member of Task Team 5: Outreach, Communication and Statistical Literacy**, together with ILO, PARIS21, UNITAR and China International Statistical Training Center.
